## NOTICE TO VONGOLE FISHERY

## Information on electronic reporting for the Vongole Fishery

Dear Licence holder

I write to provide an update on the implementation of electronic reporting for the Vongole Fishery to replace the current paper-based system.

A simple electronic catch reporting system has been developed that will enable fishers to report their catch for Vongole quota. This will improve the integrity and reliability of the quota arrangements in the fishery and result in a more effective and efficient management of the Vongole Fishery.

Fishers will now be able to report their catch by using the Commercial Fishing SA app. The app has been configured to report electronic catch disposal records (eCDRs). In addition, fishers can access eCatch through the myPIRSA portal and report their catch directly into eCatch.

Particulars about eCDR reporting have been detailed within the 'Vongole Fishery – Electronic Reporting Reference Guide' which will be provided to all licence holders.

Fishers are to commence reporting electronically from **4 August 2023** and will be required to dual report their catch until advised (dual reporting requires fishers to report their catch using a paperbased CDR as well as the new electronic eCDR). This will allow for the monitoring of eCDRs to ensure the accuracy of their entries during the dual reporting period.

Fishers are to ensure when inputting details on their paper-based CDR, they hand write the electronic report reference (e.g. G01230630A) of their equivalent eCDR on the paper-based copy in the top right corner (see following image). This will allow for appropriate validation of submissions, as shown below.
