

# Tomato brown rugose fruit virus (ToBRFV)

ToBRFV is a plant disease that spreads easily. It affects **tomatoes, capsicums and chillies**. It doesn't affect humans but is a significant threat to Australia's vegetable industry.



## What should I look for?

- Yellow mottling of leaves and fruit
- Brown wrinkled spots on fruit
- Uneven ripening (green stripes or blotches)



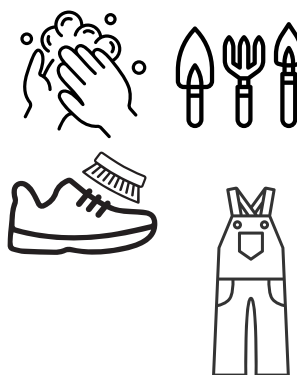
## What should I do next?

**Leave** any suspicious plants  
where they are



**Clean your equipment,  
shoes and hands** before  
you move to another  
greenhouse or property.  
**Wear different clothes.**



**Do not compost** tomatoes or  
capsicums



**Do not take** fruit grown  
outside to greenhouses
