

Fisheries Management (Fish Processors) Regulations 2017

For the purpose of regulation 11 relating to the processing of Blue Swimmer Crab – I make the following determinations –

**Regulation 11(1)(a) (record information) and Regulation 11(1)(c) (Arrangements for fish)**

- (1) A registered fish processor who purchases or obtains Blue Swimmer Crab from—
- (a) the holder of a licence or permit in respect of the Blue Crab Fishery; or
  - (b) the holder of a licence in respect of the Marine Scalefish Fishery that is subject to a condition fixing a Blue Swimmer Crab quota entitlement; or
  - (c) an agent of the holder of a licence or permit referred to in paragraph (a) or (b),

must— on taking delivery of the Blue Swimmer Crab immediately weigh the Blue Swimmer Crab and immediately complete the certificate contained in Part B of the Blue Crab Catch and Disposal Record (BSCF1) record in respect of the Blue Swimmer Crab.

- (2) Where a registered fish processor processes Blue Swimmer Crab he or she must keep an accurate record of all purchases, sales, movements and transfers; and

Ensure that these records are-

- (d) maintained in good condition and are legible;
- (e) kept in a readily accessible place; and
- (f) able to be produced for inspection by a Fisheries Officer on request.

**Regulation 11(1)(b) (Provide information)**

- (1) A registered fish processor who purchases or obtains Blue Swimmer Crab from—
- (a) the holder of a licence or permit in respect of the Blue Crab Fishery; or
  - (b) the holder of a licence in respect of the Marine Scalefish Fishery that is subject to a condition fixing a Blue Swimmer Crab quota entitlement; or
  - (c) an agent of the holder of a licence or permit referred to in paragraph (a) or (b),

may within 24 hours of taking delivery of the blue crab to which the record relates, transmit a copy of the record to the Department via fax on 08 8204 1388 and;

must within 24 hours of taking delivery of the blue crab to which the record relates, deliver, or cause to be delivered, the completed record to the Department in a reply paid envelope or to;

**Regulation 11(3) (keeping records)**

- (1) A registered fish processor must keep copies of all completed BSCF1 records relating to the Blue Swimmer Crab purchased or obtained by the registered fish processor for a period of 12 months.
