The term 'personal affairs' has been held to involve 'matters of private concern to an individual' and the 'composite collection of activities personal to the individual concerned'.

An Aviation Reference Number (ARN) is a unique identifier to a customer.

As a mobile telephone number allows a person, including an officer of an agency, to be contacted outside of business hours and is information that is not ordinarily available to the public, the information is taken to concern the personal affairs of an individual.

With respect to the removal of the names of CASA officers, there would be an expectation that their personal information would not be released in this way.

Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

Good morning Tim,

Thank you for your email. It seems as though it may be better to renew the ReOC and supply the Operations Manual amendments at a later stage.

The ReOC renewal process doesn't allow for scope changes; only general matters such as the addition/removal of a business name, change of legal entity name where the legal entity remains the same, and removal of scope such as a category.

If you were intending on varying the ReOC such as for the addition of an RPA category, this takes a minimum of four weeks to process and sometimes(at no obligation) the ReOC renewal may discretionally be incorporated with that job. The RePL ratings need to be covered and it appears that that isn't the case in this instance.

If you'd still like a call please advise.
