## NOTICE TO SARDINE FISHERY LICENCE HOLDERS

## Inclusion of approved bin or container

## Dear Licence holder

I write to advise you that, as delegate of the Minister for Primary Industries and Regions, I have approved a new Ministerial Determination relating to regulations 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(c) of the *Fisheries Management (Sardine Fishery) Regulation 2021*, prescribing bin or container types approved for use in the Sardine Fishery. The new determination revokes the current determination and replaces it with a new determination in the same form but for the changes noted here.

This new determination provides for a new type of bin in schedule 1 of the Determinations, prescribing the following:

- o Referred to as "AFE Ex SMF Tall Ally"
- o Internal dimensions 1800 x 1100 x 900 mm
- Painted with a blue line at the top
- Certified weight for the bin type of 1550 kg will apply when the bin is filled level with the top of the bin
- Tare weight of 154 kg.

Please also note the following additional amendments:

- 1. "Bin Type 4 SMF Ex Eyre Tuna Ally Bin" has been removed from Schedule 1 of the Determinations.
- 2. Removal of 'Paragraph 4' in the Title of Schedule 1 which now reads "Register of bins for the purposes of this Determination made under Regulation 12(1)(a) (record information) and Regulation 12(1)(c) (arrangements for fish)".
- 3. Correction AFE bin 1 amendment of "Tally" to "Tall".
