This brief history of the Horticulture Branch contains a list of former staff members, their last title, last location and period of service (minimum of 12 months). Included are all sections, Research, Extension, Inspection, Orchard Staff, Fruit Fly Staff, Road Block Staff, Clerical Staff working with the Branch or Plant Industry, Seeds girls and Typing girls.

The Horticulture Branch owes its existence to the fruit industries of South Australia, more accurately to the apple and viticultural industries pressuring the Government of the day to "control the advent of the dreaded fruit flies, Phylloxera and codlin moth, as well as many other diseases not yet established in the Colony".

Agitation by the wine industry produced the "Vines Protection Act, 1874" who then promptly complained of inadequacy of the Act and in 1878 a further "Act For the Prevention and Eradication of Diseases in Vines" was passed. Inspectors were appointed under these two Acts but were committed initially to the Chief Secretary (1874) and then to the Commissioner of Crown Lands (1878 and 1885).

Further agitation finally produced the "Vine, Fruit and Vegetable Protection Act, 1885" where almost limitless powers for the control and eradication of pests and diseases were available to the inspectors.

No clear-cut portfolio of agriculture emerged until 1901 when a Minister of Agriculture was first appointed. The intervening years vassalated between the Commission of Crown Lands and the Minister of Education.

A "First Annual Progress Report" under the heading "Department of Agriculture, December 31, 1882" was printed as Parliamentary Paper No. 33 in 1883, under the authorship of John D. Custance, F.C.S., Etc., Government Professor of Agriculture, South Australia.

"Section 1

In October, 1879, Mr. Basedow brought before the House of Assembly the following motion "that in the opinion of this House, it is desirable that the Government should take steps, with as little delay as possible, to establish, in connection with the Adelaide University, a College of Agriculture, and also, as a necessary appendage thereto and within a convenient distance from the city, and Experimental Farm for the purpose of encouraging a more rational mode of farming than at present obtains in South Australia".

After a lengthy debate the following question passed in the affirmative by a majority of eight votes. "That in the opinion of this House, it is desirable steps should be taken to establish a School of Agriculture, and also as a necessary appendage thereto, and within a convenient distance from the city an Experimental Farm, and to appoint an experienced and skilful Professor of Agriculture, for the purpose of encouraging a more rational mode of farming than at present obtains in South Australia". (Blue Book, Volume 1, 1879).

Section 2

In consequence of this resolution, an experienced Professor of Agriculture was selected by Sir Arthur Blyth, the Agent General (in London) assisted by a Committee of Gentlemen, the specified duties of the professor being "to superintend an Experimental Farm already established, to study the climate of South Australia and its various soils, and to advise the Government on all points bearing on the well-being of the agricultural community of South Australia".

Roseworthy College:

Farm bought in 1881 for £6 per acre.

First wheat crop a failure in 1882.

Building opened for students in 1885.

Vineyard established 1885 (from vines supplied by Thomas Hardy. A planting 10' x 8' in rows of 20 vines of each: Shiraz, Mataro, Riesling, Verdat, Pride of Australia, Fronignac, Carbonet, with Muscat Alexandria, Gordo Blanco, Doradilla and Goulais as fillers.

Prof. Lawrie takes up post of Principal in 1887.

<u>Prof. A.J. Perkins</u> publishes hints on the treatment of vine cuttings in Roseworthy Annual Report, 1892.

Agitation for a Department of Agriculture continues - although it is not clear where the School of Agriculture and the Department of Agriculture begin and end.

A lengthy and spirited plea for the establishment of "A Department of Agriculture" was made by Prof. Custance at a meeting in the Hall of the Chamber of Manufacturers on Friday evening, August 22, 1884 chaired by Sir S. Davenport (President of the Chamber). There was a numerous attendance.

Further meetings and agitation continues until the end of the century.

Department of Agriculture:

Annual Reports of the Department are to be found in "Parliamentary Papers" bound into what was called the "Blue Books" each year. From 1921 when the Public Service Commissioner was appointed, annual reports of the Public Service Commissioner are also found in the Blue Books. A Public Service List of officers dates from 1918 and together with the Annual Reports of the Department of Agriculture and our own orchard diaries and files provide the sources of information. All sources make some interesting reading and reflect not only the history of Horticulture Branch, but of the whole State. So much is of interest that it is difficult not to be "side tracked" to other issues, e.g. the early wine trade to the United Kingdom was handled by the Agent General in London during the 1870's and 1880's, thus operating in a commercial way long before this Department was established.

Orchard cash books of Blackwood and Coromandel Valley include activities at the Hackney Road and Fullarton annexes and Berri Orchard and Loxton Research Centre provide details (in the early days) of salaries and purchases, sale of fruit, and many insights into the social structure of the day.

So far as the Horticulture Branch is concerned, life was not meant to be easy and I $^{\circ} ve$ extracted some items from various sources to illustrate why.

- 1908 Experimental orchards were established at Kybybolite in 1908 12 acres (first officer-in-charge was Ted Leishman) in Hackney Road 1908, Blackwood 1908 and by Lands Department at Berri the same year.
- 1910 On July 29, snow fell on the hills surrounding the Blackwood Experimental Orchard. The resultant flooding removed parts of the orchard. Again on August 19 heavy rain resulted in flooding.
- $\frac{1913}{2}$ October 6 excess water for Hackney Road orchard paid £1/2/6 (½ year). April 12 10 lb. gelegnite (7/7d.), 100 No. 6 detonators (3/3d.) for Blackwood Orchard.
- 1915 E.W. Rowell, Senior Horticultural Inspector, 1903-1915. Lieut. Colonel Commanding Officer, 3rd Light Horse Regiment, dies of an illness at Gallipoli.
 - 1917 Kybybolite trees not growing very well severe hail damage.
- 1918 600 boxes of apples from the Kybybolite orchard were cold stored as well as considerable quantities of local sales made.

George Quin was called - Horticultural Instructor, Chief Inspector of Fruit, Inspector of Fertilisers, Hay, Chaff, Insecticides, etc. - salary £600 p.a.

 $\underline{1919}$ J.B. Harris stationed in Mt. Gambier received £65 as a travelling allowance for the year.

Octavius Brown, Senior Inspector, stationed in Adelaide received $\pounds 20$ p.a. for the use of a bicycle.

Percy Trimmer, Inspector of Orchards, received £30 p.a. as a forage allowance.

- 1922 Percy Trimmer, Inspector of Orchards in Adelaide, received £40 p.a. for a motor cycle.
 - Cec. Grasby appointed Assistant Orchardist, Blackwood.
- 1926 Regulation mileage allowances introduced. 8 pence per mile for motor cars. 3 pence per mile for bicycles and motor cycles (plus £4 per year tyre allowance).
 - 1927 Mileage allowance reduced from 8 pence to 7 pence per mile.
- 1929 "Horticultural Adviser F.R. Arndt traverses the areas of Berri, Winkie, Glossop. Lone Gum, Monash, Renmark, Block E, Chaffey and Lyrup has covered 3,830 miles in making 1,080 visits to blockers. He claims to have visited all blockers once and many others on several occasions". Annual Report.
- "Mr. J.B. Harris whose extensive district embraces all of the important fruit and vine districts extending from Wilmington in the north to Salisbury and Kersbrook in the south, has travelled 6,376 miles by rail, 3,348 by his private motor car and 377 miles by other means, or 10,101 miles in all in the course of his work. He has addressed 10 Agricultural Bureau meetings, inspected 922 orchards and gardens acted as judge of fruit tree pruning in the Lower North Branches of the Agricultural Bureau". Annual Report).

- 1931 "The clerical staff, Mr. P.F. Supple and Miss Russell, have dispatched 2,015 letters, 1,816 for the State and 199 in connection with Commonwealth administration; circulars 95; telegrams 34; visitors to the Head of the Branch 528". (Geo. Quinn now Chief Horticultural Instructor). (Annual Report).
- 1935 Among the 20 third year Roseworthy students who under the supervision of Mr. J.L. Williams, Superintendent of Vineyard and Orchard, and examined in budding, grafting, and pruning methods by the officer-incharge, Blackwood Experimental Orchard, Mr. R. Fowler, were:- Muirhead, Orchard, Chamberlain, Cowley and Cilchrist.
- 1936 Noted in 1936 as dux of the pruning examinations J.R. Nourse. Others in the class were: A.J.K. Walker, H.E. Orchard and A.R. Griffith.
- A.G. Strickland appointed Chief Horticulturist vice Geo. Quinn, retired.
 - 1937 First research officer, H.K. Kemp, appointed.

 $\underline{1939}$ Rent for house at Blackwood - £47/3/4 per annum. Rent for house at Berri - £45/-/-. Chief Horticulturist salary £721/7/3 per annum.

1940 September 15 - Rodney Fowler's last day at work (Blackwood Orchard). Replaced by Ted Leishman on December 16, 1940.

The War Years - 1939-46

The years of World War II were also not meant to be easy. J.B. Harris landed the management problems of the Viticultural Station as well as his normal huge northern advisory district for the duration. Sun Halliday, in charge of the Berri Orchard, was inundated with requests for vegetable trial work, the production of vegetable seed (in very short supply in 1941-42), dehydration of vegetable trials, and the production of nursery trees for War Service Land Settlement in the Riverland. Land Army girls were a great help on the Station.

Adviser Cec Grasby was seconded to the Army at Loveday as Captain in charge of a sea of P.O.W's. and Japanese internees growing vegetables, linseed for seed, gayule for rubber, poppies for opium and heroin, peas blue boiler, beans lima, soya beans, tomatoes, cotton S.A.D.R. for seed, nicotiana rustica, carrots for night operations, etc., etc.

Field staff were required to monitor National Security (Vegetable Seeds) Regulations, National Security (Potatoes) Regulations, Apple and Pear Requisitions, Supply of Fertilisers, Seeds, Labour, Petrol, etc., etc.

In 1941 Australia was struggling to feed one in six of its population in the Services with some very inadequate equipment. In 1942 a second Army (U.S.) arrived and also required to be fed. The U.S.A. involvement provided some lend-lease canning equipment and the present citrus juice industry started at B.C.P.U., and in a Seppelt's shed at Nuriootpa using dairy vacreators. Not too much of the production got to the Australian Services.
