

Fisheries Management (General) Regulations 2017

Regulation 5, Schedule 6, Clause 124

Temporary use a registered boat for a purpose other than under a fishery authority

Manner and form of notification required

For the purposes of clause 124, Schedule 6 of the Fisheries Management (General) Regulations 2017, I make the following determination commencing as at the date of this notice -

1. Where the holder of a fishery licence or their registered master intends to use a boat registered to their fishing authority to engage in a fishing activity other than a fishing activity under their fishery authority the licence holder or registered master must notify the Department prior to departing on the fishing trip by the telephone to Fishwatch on 1800 065 522, or the Commercial Fishing SA app and provide the following information -
 - a) the name of the licence holder(s) or registered master(s)
 - b) the licence number
 - c) the number of the registered commercial boat
 - d) the registered boat survey number
 - e) the Port you are leaving from to use the de-registered commercial boat
 - f) the commencement date to use the de-registered commercial boat
 - g) the commencement time to use the de-registered commercial boat
 - h) the completion date using the de-registered commercial boat
 - i) the completion time using the de-registered commercial boat
 - j) the reason for de-registering the registered commercial boat for an alternative use.
