



DECLARATION FOR POTATOES/SWEET POTATOES TPP (Tomato Potato Psyllid)

FOR POTATO TUBERS ENTERING SOUTH AUSTRALIA FROM STATE COVERED BY CANDIDATUS
LIBERIBACTER SOLANACEARUM (Clso) AREA FREEDOM CERTIFICATE (State free of Clso but not TPP).
Condition 17(1)1.2 and 17(3.3) – SA Plant Quarantine Standard (PQS).

Important Notes:

- Due to TPP/Clso potato tubers (including sweet potatoes) have restricted entry into South Australia. Hosts include solanaceous and convolvulaceae plants and plant material, fruit vegetables, nursery stock, as well as machinery, equipment used for production or manipulation of host material.
- Potatoes and Sweet Potatoes from a State/Territory covered by a current State Area Freedom Certificate for Clso must enter in accordance with TPP provisions in PQS Condition 17.3.3 accompanied by a Declaration, declaring compliance with that condition along with relevant details as set out below.
- When completing this Declaration you must provide all required information to ensure your host potatoes can be assessed and cleared for entry into South Australia.
- Ensure the Declaration is prepared for presentation prior to arrival into South Australia as Declarations can not be completed post-entry or at a Quarantine Station/Roadblock.
- Penalties up to \$10,000 apply for providing false or misleading information
