

Application to use Nobivac inactivated rabies vaccine

For post-exposure prophylaxis following potential exposure to Australian bat lyssavirus

Nobivac inactivated rabies vaccine is not registered for general use in Australia; however, it may be used under APVMA permit (PER14236) to provide post-exposure prophylaxis to animals following potential exposure to Australian bat lyssavirus (ABLV). Veterinarians do not need to submit this application to prepare cats and dogs for export from Australia.

The permit requires authorisation, on a case-by-case basis, from a state/territory Chief Veterinary Officer before the rabies vaccine can be used for this purpose.

Conditions of Authorisation by South Australia's Chief Veterinary Officer

- The vaccine must be used as per the critical use comments and conditions of PER14236
- The vaccine must only be administered by the veterinarian(s) authorised by the South Australia Chief Veterinary Officer to the animal/s identified in this application.
- The ABLV post-exposure vaccination and monitoring protocol must be completed as described in [ABLV Post-exposure vaccination guidelines with Nobivac rabies inactivated vaccine](#) or as otherwise advised by the South Australia Chief Veterinary Office (CVO).
- Vaccinated animals must be microchipped.
- The owner should be informed that information about potential exposures to ABLV, including information about the owner, may be provided to SA Health to facilitate management of risks to human health.
