This is a Bee and Bee Commodity Entry Application, and is not to be assumed to be or used as permission to enter South Australia.

Following receipt of a completed entry application, the issuing of a Chief Inspector of Stock Permission may take up to five days.

When completing this entry application, any attachments included must be identifiable by name and brand, be legible, and include the total number of pages attached.

Providing false or misleading information is an offence under the *Livestock Act 1997*:

- Sec. 75 - False or misleading information: A person must not make a statement that is false or misleading in a material particular (whether by reason of the inclusion or omission of any particular) in any information furnished, or record kept, under this Act. - Maximum Penalty: If the person made the statement knowing that it was false or misleading - \$10,000; in any other case - \$5,000.
- additionally, providing incorrect or incomplete information may lead to delays or non-issuance of a permit.

Permits are valid for a maximum of 10 days to allow for multiple movements to occur. If seeking a longer timeframe nominate a maximum end date _____

All fields in all the entry application and associated records must be completed (if a field is not applicable, mark N/A - not applicable).

Any permission is granted on the basis of the information supplied by the applicant.

Please note: This application form must be forwarded onto PIRSA Bee Biosecurity for assessment prior to the movement occurring. Processing of your application will take at least 5 working days where PIRSA will either:

- (a) provide Chief Inspector of Stock permission (inclusive of transit/transport conditions and post-entry management conditions).
- (b) contact applicant to clarify aspects of the application(s) as required.
- (c) refuse the application via a Chief Inspector of Stock refusal notice

Definitions: All definitions are from the Gazette Notice dated 19 July 2023 and the *Guideline for bee and bee commodity entry application*, and apply equally to this entry application.

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4. Declaration

- am aware of the current NSW Varroa mite Eradication Emergency Zones (EEZ's) and Varroa mite Surveillance Emergency Zones (SEZ's), having last checked the maps on the NSW Department of Primary Industries website at www.dpi.nsw.gov.au _____ (record date checked website), and have not had bees, bee colonies, hive components, apiary products, apiary appliances, and beekeeping plant located in or associated with bees, bee colonies, hive components, apiary products, apiary appliances, and beekeeping plant located at any time since 1 January 2021 in any areas declared under a current NSW Biosecurity (Varroa Mite) Emergency Order as a EEZ or a SEZ.
- have not had bees, bee colonies, hive components, apiary products, apiary appliances, and beekeeping plant located in or associated with bees, bee colonies, hive components, apiary products, apiary appliances, and beekeeping plant been located in or associated with colonies located in any other State or Territory within which Varroa mite has been detected and reported by any relevant State or Territory authority responsible for any Act or Regulation equivalent to the *Livestock Act 1997*.
- agree to continue to comply with the conditions specified by the Chief Inspector of Stock,
- will, if at any stage I become aware of any non-compliance, am unable to comply with, or do not understand the conditions specified by the Chief Inspector of Stock, notify an inspector under the *Livestock Act 1997* in writing (preferably via the relevant records), emailed to PIRSA.beebiosecurity@sa.gov.au the same day I became aware of the non-compliance/ am unable to comply/ do not understand.
- am aware that the Department of Primary Industries and Regions has penalties for breaches of the *Livestock Act 1997* including of Chief Inspector of Stock Conditions, including prosecution, eviction, quarantine and/ or destruction.
- have completed this application and the information contained herein is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
