Dear Removed from Disclosure Log

Determination under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* which was received by the Department of Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) on 6 January 2025, seeking access to the following:

"I request access to documents held by the Department of Primary Industries and Regions relating to the South Australian Wild Dog Bounty Scheme. Specifically, I would like to request documents recording the number of bounty applications submitted, the number approved/granted, and the number rejected or declined, including any summaries, reports, spreadsheets, databases, or internal records that capture these figures by year or reporting period. I would also like to request photographs or digital images submitted as part of bounty applications, including all images provided by applicants to support claims under the Wild Dog Bounty Scheme."

Timeframe: 1/04/2020 to 6/01/2026

Accordingly, the following determination has been finalised.

I have located 701 photographs, compiled into one document, and four additional documents that are captured within the scope of your request.

Determination 1

I have determined that access to the following documents is **granted in part**:

The information removed from the above documents is pursuant to Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act which states:

“6 - Documents affecting personal affairs

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).”

The information removed from Documents 1, 2 and 5 consists of the following: images of distinguishable property including shoes, buildings, automobiles and a personal firearm, images of distinguishable shadows of third parties, location data, names of third parties and an email of a third party.

The information removed from Documents 3 and 4 consists of the following: names and emails of third parties.

Further to this, it is noted that the guidelines for the Wild Dog Bounty Scheme do not require inclusion of these personal details.

The term ‘personal affairs’ has been held to involve ‘matters of private concern to an individual’ and the ‘composite collection of activities personal to the individual concerned.

Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

The remaining information removed is outside of the scope of your request.
