Rock Lobster Restrictions

Restrictions apply to recreational Rock Lobster fishing from the

GPS coordinates based on Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94).


Port MacDonnell breakwater.

Rod and line, handline and hand net fishing only is permitted. Fishers are prohibited from using any other device, including pots, drop nets, crab nets, hoop nets and snares from the breakwater or anywhere within the restricted area.

When taking Rock Lobster outside the restricted area, the following rules apply:

Size limit: 9.85 cm Bag limit: 4 Boat limit: 8 (where two or more people are onboard)

Note: All Southern Rock Lobster must have the middle tail fan clipped in half horizontally before landing. A seasonal closure applies from 6 pm 31 May to 6 am 1 October in the Southern Zone.



Maximum penalty of \$35,000 applies.
