

Fisheries Management (Fish Processors) Regulations 2017
Regulations 15A, 15B, 15C and 15D

Revocation

The Determination made for the purposes of regulations 15A, 15B, 15C and 15D dated 1 July 2021 will be revoked as of 14 July 2026.

Determination

For the purpose of regulations 15A, 15B, 15C and 15D relating to the processing of King George Whiting, Snapper, Southern Calamari and Southern Garfish by a Restricted Fish Processors Registration Holder who also holds a Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence commencing 15 July 2026, I make the following determination –

Electronic Reporting

Regulations 15A(1), 15B(1), 15C(1), 15D(1) (electronically record and provide fish processor information)

A Restricted Fish Processors Registration Holder who has taken possession of King George Whiting, Snapper, Southern Calamari or Southern Garfish taken from a fishing zone as described in the Fisheries Management (Marine Scalefish Fishery) Regulations 2017 must -

- (1) Complete an electronic Sales and Consignment record for any King George Whiting, Snapper, Southern Calamari or Southern Garfish immediately after the fish are sold or leave the Restricted Fish Processors Registration Holder's possession including in that record:
 - (a) The registration number of the Restricted Fish Processors Registration Holder;
 - (b) The name of the Restricted Fish Processors Registration Holder;
 - (c) The date of consignment;
 - (d) Species, drop-down selection (Snapper, King George Whiting, Southern Calamari or Southern Garfish);
 - (e) Condition, drop-down selection (whole, filleted, gilled and gutted, gutted, heads, wings, tubes/mantles);
 - (f) The weight (kg), to one decimal of the Snapper, King George Whiting, Southern Calamari or Southern Garfish); and
 - (g) Details of who the Snapper, King George Whiting, Southern Calamari or Southern Garfish were sold to.

Regulations 15A(3), 15B(3), 15C(3), 15D(3) (keep records)

- (1) Where an electronic report has been completed and received by the Department pursuant to regulations 15A(1), 15B(1), 15C(1) and 15D(1), no further record needs to be kept for the purposes of this determination.

For the purposes of this determination –

Department – means the Department of Primary Industries and Regions South Australia.

Electronic report – means an entry received in the eCatch electronic database created and administered by the Department. Submission of the electronic report may be directly entered into the eCatch electronic database via the myPIRSA portal (www.pir.sa.gov.au/ecatch) or via the Commercial Fishing SA App.

Restricted Fish Processor Registration Holder – means a fish processor who is also the holder of a Marine Scalefish fishery licence and can only process aquatic resources taken under the fishery authority.
