

Fisheries Management (Vongole Fishery) Regulations 2021

Regulation 15

Revocation

The Determination made for the purposes of regulation 15, dated 19 January 2025 will be revoked as of 1 August 2026.

Determination

For the purpose of regulation 15 relating to Periodic Returns to be provided and kept by Vongole Fishery licence holders, I make the following determination commencing 1 August 2026 –

Electronic records and reporting

Licence holders must complete electronic C&E/CDR reports and comply with reporting requirements as described in this part.

Regulation 15(1) (provide return)

- (1) The holder of a licence in respect of the Vongole Fishery must -
 - (a) Complete an electronic report through a Vongole – C&E/CDR report in respect of each day that fishing activity is undertaken during the currency of the licence.
 - (b) An electronic Vongole – C&E/CDR report is to be submitted on or before point of landing, prior to entering processor premises.

Regulation 15(2) (keeping records)

- (1) Where an electronic report through a Vongole C&E/CDR report has been completed and received by the Department pursuant to regulation 15(1) under this determination, no further record needs be kept for the purposes of this determination.

For the purposes of this determination:

Electronic C&E/CDR report – means an entry received in the eCatch electronic database created and administered by the Department. Under this determination this is a Vongole–C&E/CDR report. Submission of the electronic report may be directly entered into the eCatch electronic database via the myPIRSA portal (www.pir.sa.gov.au/ecatch); via the Commercial Fishing SA App; or other third party application. If entered by a third party application the Licence Holder, or Nominated Agent must ensure the report has been received by the eCatch electronic database.

Day – means a period commencing at midnight and ending at midnight the following day.

Department – means the administrative unit of the Public Service responsible for assisting a Minister in the administration of the Fisheries Management Act 2007
