

# South Australian Grains

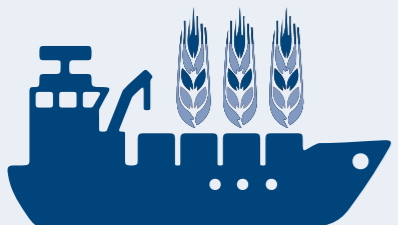
### Snapshot

South Australia grows around **four million hectares of grain crop** each year, including wheat, barley, lentils and canola. **The farmgate value in 2024-25 reached \$2.1 billion.**

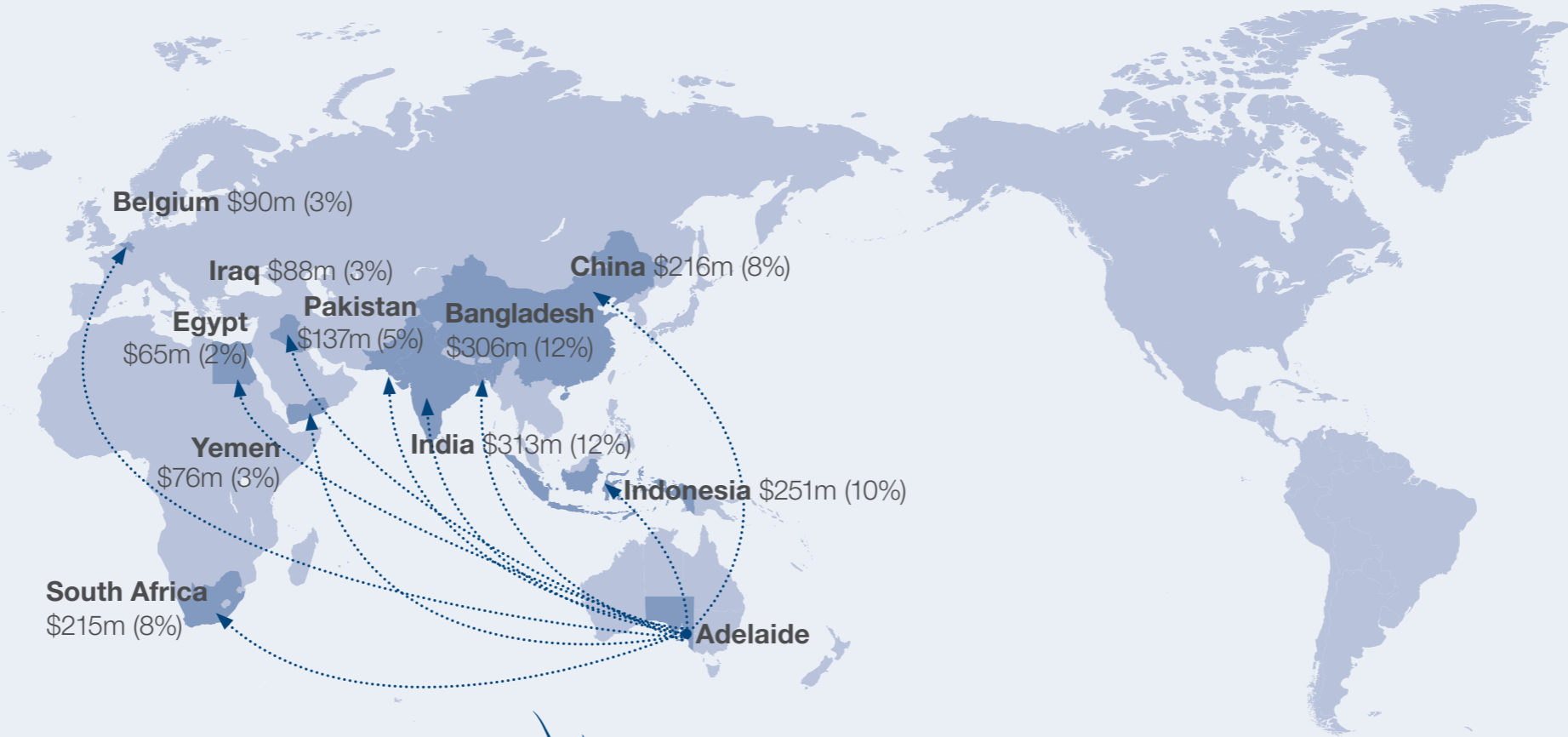

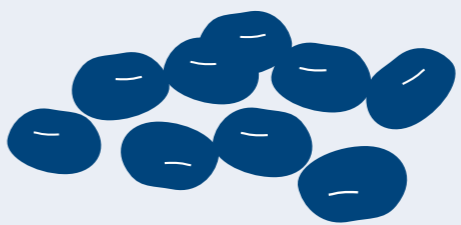
