Payment Methods:

1. POST Application to PIRSA Fisheries & Aquaculture, GPO Box 1625, ADELAIDE SA 5001. On receipt of the application, a PIRSA representative will contact you to obtain payment by credit card. **Cash and Cheques are no longer accepted.**
2. In PERSON (payment by **credit card/Eftpos only**) at PIRSA offices located at Adelaide (2 Hamra Avenue, West Beach. SA 5024) and Mount Gambier (9 Krummel Street).

INSTRUCTIONS TO MESH NET REGISTRATION HOLDERS

You must have a valid Lake George mesh net registration (and a valid tag fitted to your net) before you can use a mesh net in South Australian waters. Your mesh net must comply with Fisheries Regulations.

A numbered tag issued by PIRSA **MUST BE** attached to the top of the rope near the yellow buoy, so that it is visible above the surface of the water, when the net is in use. In the case of a lost or stolen tag, you will be required to apply to PIRSA Fisheries & Aquaculture for a replacement tag to be issued. Applications for a replacement tag can be made in person at a PIRSA Fisheries & Aquaculture office or by telephoning PIRSA Fisheries & Aquaculture on (08) 8207 5332 to request a form. A fee of **\$38.00** applies to the issue of a replacement tag.

Mesh nets used in Lake George must be attended by the registered owner between one and a half hours after sunrise and one and a half hours before sunset on the same day. The net is not required to be attended outside of these times.

Attendance of your net means the registered owner must be no more than 50 m from the landward boundary of the Lake.

Please note: this registration is an 'authority' for the purposes of section 116 of the *Fisheries Management Act 2007* and as such the registration holders full name and postal address will appear on the public register.
