INFORMATION ABOUT THE PERMIT APPLICATION

The application should be completed in the name of the aquaculture licence holder. A permit for collection of broodstock or seedstock can only be issued to the holder of an aquaculture licence issued under the *Aquaculture Act 2001*.

It is preferred that a commercial fishery licence holder is used to access to the required species is used for broodstock collection. In that case a permit is not required. Approval for broodstock or seedstock collection will only be granted to current licence holders under the *Aquaculture Act 2001*. Please note, that in the case of Abalone translocation regulations, and associated quarantine procedures apply, and are the responsibility of the Aquaculture licence holder.

In the event of additional costs such as a public notice to mariners, specific marking requirements as requested by the Department of Planning Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI), the applicant will be responsible to pay for the associated costs.

PIRSA is interested in the applicant's ability to capture and maintain broodstock and seedstock in good condition. Failure to adequately describe all aspects of the collection process may result in the application being rejected.
