**Adoption of Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery
and NEW Fishing Licences from 1 August 2022**

Dear Licence Holder

I am pleased to inform you that the new *Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery (2022)* (the Plan), was adopted by the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development on 6 July 2022.

The Plan will come into effect on 1 August 2022, to align with the expiry of the current plan on 31 July 2022. The Plan will be available from 1 August 2022 on the Department for Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) website at:

The Plan incorporates several strategic policy priorities to be addressed prior to the mid-term review of the Plan.

New licences will be issued to be valid from 1 August 2022 to 31 July 2032, in line with the term of the new *Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery*, as required by Section 56(1)(b)(i) of the *Fisheries Management Act 2007*. If you have submitted your Application for an Authority form, your new licence certificate will be sent to you prior to 1 August 2022.
