Determination under the Freedom of Information Act 1991

The information removed from the above documents is pursuant to Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act which states:

"6 - Documents affecting personal affairs

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."

The information removed consists of the following:

- Names of complainants
- Street addresses of complainants
- Mobile telephone numbers of complainants
- Email addresses of complainants
- Other identifying information of complainants, including particular property features which could identify specific locations
- Mobile telephone numbers of PIRSA fruit fly hotline officers
- Landline numbers of PIRSA fruit fly hotline officers (Documents 24, 42 and 125)
- Name of a veterinarian (Document 98)

It is considered that members of the public can lodge a complaint with a public sector agency without fear that their identities are released.

The mobile telephone numbers of the PIRSA fruit fly officers are considered exempt as a mobile telephone number allows a person, including an officer of an agency, to be contacted outside of business hours and is information that is not ordinarily available to the public, the information is taken to concern the personal affairs of an individual.

This is further substantiated by the requirement for members of the public to contact the Fruit Fly Hotline number listed on the PIRSA website and not direct to their mobile or work telephone numbers.

Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

The remaining information removed from Documents 11, 20, 41, 42, 43, 52, 76, 83, 95, 108 and 116 does not constitute as the actual complaint and is outside of the scope of your request. Document 83 contains information removed which concerns an unrelated matter and is also out of scope.

- She would like to know what substance it is.
- There are no fruit trees on property
- She is sick of the regular visits and does not see the necessity for the visits.

^{Clause 6(1)} mentioned she has had a number of visits to her property and every time they tell her she has a number of fruit trees including olive as its recorded in their data base. She claims she does not have any and is wondering why this hasn't been recorded.

Is it worth sending someone to her house to make a final inspection and make sure we have the correct data recorded on our system to avoid the constant flow of teams? Perhaps this can be achieved when someone visits to move/take down the trap.



I have spoken to ^{Clause 6(1)} this morning. She came home last Wednesday 24.5.23 to find that one of her dogs was dead. She took the dog to the Vet and he said that it looked like a blunt trauma, so likely the dog had been hit. ^{Clause 6(1)} said that all of her neighbours had access cards left but she did not. ^{Clause 6(1)} said that the road is a "no through" road, so generally no passing traffic and she suspects that her dog may have been accidently hit by the team and they did not realise. The dog is small. I looked on the ipad and saw the team were in the area on that day. Under baiting notes it states "Contact made: No" " Problem accessing property: Yes." No bait applied. It then says "NFT Natives only. Dog in enclosed space, dog loose"

Clause 6(1) said she is not calling to ask for compensation or accuse anyone of hitting her dog. She said that there is nothing anyone can do. She said that the other dog, which happens to be the Mother of the dog that died, is very stressed and keeps escaping from the yard. She has had to lock her in the laundry today. Clause 6(1) said that she only has natives and is requesting no return for baiting as she is concerned the other dog will be run over.

Please can you call as soon as possible to discuss? She was very reasonable to me. Just very upset over her dog dying.

His hydraulic gate being broken (able to be fixed but no ownership by PIRSA for the damage). He stated he rang the day it happened but got given the run around. He showed me how this may have happened and it could have been an easy mistake and could have easily been caused by one of our teams

- The sorts of people he has entering his property from PIRSA, he does not trust some
- The lack of English speaking skills from some of the people he has contacting him to enter the property
- At times being called to gain entry to the property, returning back and calling the number that called him to allow access and that number then not answering his calls and no one completing the work

There were varying other complaints but had stated that at this stage he was much happier not having us enter. Myself and Shane spoke with about our need to access the properties and the legalities surrounding our ability to access. Continued on that he would be happier with no access and was speaking with others who felt the same. Charge (1) then stated that we would need the police to enter. I said I didn't think there would be the need for police with the way had been with us, but he reiterated we would need police. After a long conversation about varying things we were able to get to agree to letting us on. However, he said he would be happy if myself and Shane came back, but not just anyone. We said this was not going to be possible, but we would look to have a supervisor or team leader and just one other worker to come on so that he could watch what they were doing. He reluctantly agreed but wished these people to have good communication skills and good English. He was hoping that the same people could come to his residence consistently to build some trust with him. was specific that he would like to be present and that he had certain times that would suit him (mid-week at about 0930 to 1000). I told

that I would call him after consulting with Operations as I did not want to promise that we could come at a certain time and day if we could not live up to that. It would be great to have a good team to deal with properties such as this, where the landholder is allowing access but with conditions and has had issues with our staff in the past.




He also want to raise the questions "Can the Hygiene team and baiting team come on the same day and do it all at once? Can the same team members visit each time so they can feel more comfortable?"

I visited hives yesterday 25thof September 2023 and 7 hives and 4 nucs were visibly in distress with dead and dying bees out front of hives and Nucs.

Hi Michael,

very disappointed with Pirsas response to a spate of bee poisoning that stretches from Cooltong to Gurra downs a distance of 30 ks. Pirsa has been in attendance at every one of these events . In other words guilty by association and that is no doubt what motivates the Boffins in Pirsa, s hierarchy to write defensive comments in the Murray Ploneer.

Take the Cooltong event at CClause 6(1) . Pirsa had been in that area.

A few months back Clause 6(1) Clause 6(1) who lives near the Old Renmark High School saw Pirsa staff near his 2 hives after which he noticed a bee kill in one of his hives. Mob Clause 6(1)

Myself at Clause 6(1) . Pirsa staff were seen spraying within metres of my hive. $\frac{Clause}{6(1)}$ has been running around telling people $\frac{Clause}{Clause} \frac{6(1)}{2}$, poisoned them . I spoke to $\frac{Clause}{6(1)}$ yesterday and she maintains there is no way she poisoned my bees . I remember having the theory explained to me by Ben and David and thought what a crock full of rubbish. For the record $\frac{Clause}{Clause} \frac{6(1)}{2}$; a well educated young woman (She attended use $\frac{6(1)}{2}$) just in case you think you were dealing with an

uneducated nit wit. Because that is how you treated her.

Also your first question to me when I contacted you was "Are the bees suffocating in the hives."In other words is it Fipronil. No it was not typical of Fipronil. Ben was with me and we inspected the hives and there were very few dead bees in the hives . Instead bees were crawling out of the hives and heading away from the hives . My experience with Fipronil is that bees die in the hive plus if they make it out of the hive they are jittery -sometime rear backwards or go in circles etc . No one has satisfactorily answered my query regarding my observations as to why the poisoned bees were reacting like they did.

In the past I had contacted you in regard to minor bee kills at . But that is what they were minor and I did nothing because as the what I believed source of the poisoning down sized the so did the bee kill events.

Also while conversing with you David and Ben I mentioned that a certain person in the vicinity of Clause 6(1) and c streets had 2 years earlier I believe used Fipronil in an inappropriate way and had inadvertently affected 2 hives I had situated in Clause 6(1) . Not much later Clause 6(1) Mob₆₍₁₎ who had hives situated in the area reported to me that her hives had suffered damage similar to what I had received. Not much later Clause 6(1) who had 8 hives on the property of the person I earlier alluded to lost all 8 hives after this person baited a swarm in a shed not 50 metres from his hives . I assisted in the clean and it was typical Fipronil poisoning with just as many bees dead in the hives as outside the hives. In other words we generally have a fair idea if bee death occurs of what took place.

Clause 6(1) located this persons property on a map he had and I hope he has spoken to this person. Regarding the bee kill at clause 6(1) where the bee kill occured I believe. I believe there is a block of lucerne and mandarins nearby. If by accident insecticide was sprayed on those blocks how come my bees were not impacted.

On another point Pirsa has been conducting Fruit Fly eradication for long time now and at meetings with growers they have been advised that they should change there baiting regime from time to time to avoid Fruit Fly from developing resistance to Naturalure. Has the baiting regime been changed ? If so what spray is Pirsa using .If not why not? Because failure to do so puts the whole program in jeopardy.

Also in an article put out by a Pirsa spokes person they advise us to maintain good lines of communication with growers etc. We do not have to because growers have been looking after beekeepers for decades . They know when to spray or contact us. There are no stuff ups. Because I only have a small amount of

hives I sometimes supplement other beekeepers so I do not even meet the almond grower etc. that would be superflous . I take my hives to where directed pick them up when pollination is finished and send an invoice to the address I have been given. Pirsa could well do with adopting some of our practices. Without going into it the whole Fruit Fly eradication program it is a Public relations disaster. I have had many people tellme so.

Also the whole investigation is flawed

The compliance officer is Pirsa as is the investigative and Apiary Officer. Plus the toxicity report is Pirsa. I have received no paper work. Shades of Dracula in charge of the blood bank .

My reason for writing to you is this . There is enough circumstantial evidence to implicate Pirsa in the bee deaths that have occurred. Although there is nothing to indicate anything malicious Pirsa should compensate those who have lost bees.


