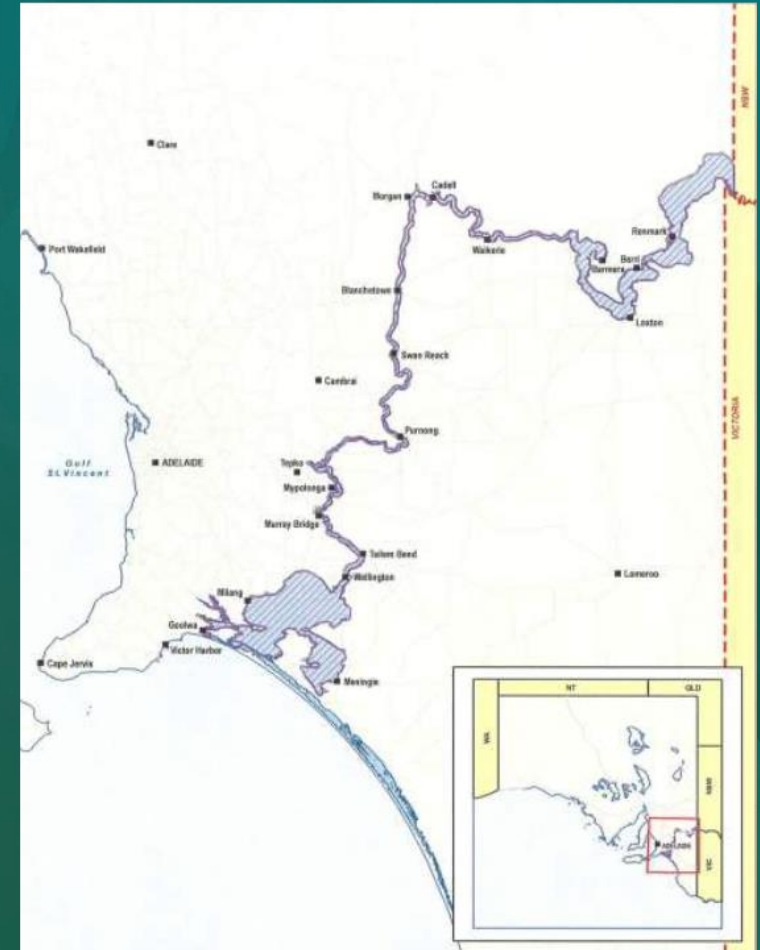


RIVER MURRAY PRESCRIBED WATERCOURSE

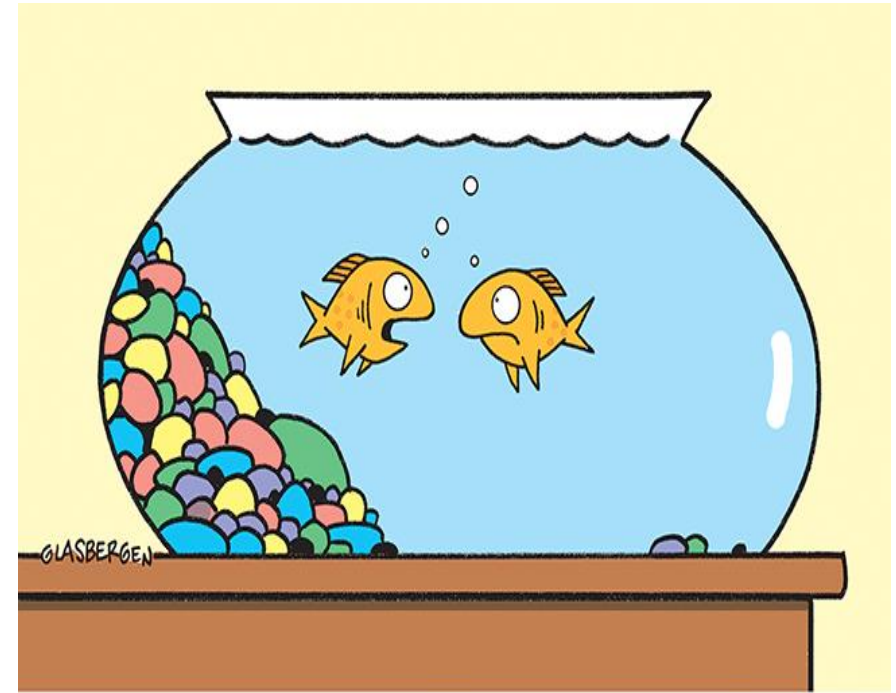


YOUR DETAILS/COMPANY DETAILS

- It is a condition on water instruments that you notify DEW of any changes to your contact details (phone, email, address) within 21 days
- Please include your contact details on the application form so the DEW can contact you if clarification is required in the regard to the application

SIGNING APPLICATIONS

- If there are two or more parties or names on the water instrument then ALL need to sign the application form unless an authority has been provided to DEW
- If the water instrument is in a company name then two signatures are required; either two company directors OR the company secretary & a director
- If a company has a sole director, please ensure you note that you are the sole director



“I’m leaving you, Gilbert. You can keep the bowl, but I’m taking the water and all of the colored stones!”

A current meter read/s is required from the seller of the allocation/share and this needs to be entered onto the application

- The quarterly and annual meter read/s needs to be taken during the first 14 calendar days of July 2020, October 2020, January 2021 and April 2021 and submitted to the Department. You are required to take meter reading(s) from each meter through which water is taken pursuant to Water Resource Works Approval.
- **Your meter reading can be submitted via one of the following options:**

INTERSTATE APPLICATIONS

- SA works in Kilolitres (KL), other States work in Megalitres (ML) (i.e. 10,000 KL = 10 ML)
- Interstate will only trade to one decimal i.e. 1.8ML or 1,800KL
- Do not use duplicate interstate reference numbers (this will result in the application being refused)
- If a trade is refused you will be advised of the reason
- Remember you need to lodge both States sets of paperwork and application fee. Sometimes customers lodge one States paperwork and forget to lodge the other States

Trade and Quarterly Accounting

- It is important to note that in order for a water trade to be considered for the Quarter in the water year, the application **MUST** be submitted to DEW before 5:00pm on the last day of the quarter e.g. quarter 1 submitted by 5pm on 30th September 2020



Trade & Quarterly Accounting cont.

- Some account holders have liaised with a Water Broker prior to the end of the quarter to ensure they have purchased allocation to balance their account. IF THE APPLICATION IS NOT LODGED with DEW by 5pm on the last day of the quarter then that volume is not considered in the account balance.
- Please ensure you advise your Water Broker if the application is to balance your account for the quarter so they can lodge the application within the time-frame



PEAK PERIODS – quarterly plus the end of water year (ends 30 June)

Message displayed on Environment and Water Connect websites:

- If your water application form is lodged after 2pm on 18 June 2021 there is no guarantee that the application will be determined in the 2020-2021 year"

And please note:

- Water trade applications can be lodged up to 5pm on 30 June, however, there is no guarantee that it will be determined in the 2020-21 water year. Interstate water trade applications must be lodged with DEW by 11am (SA Time) on 30 June 2021.

Current Requirement

VALUE OF TRADE

This needs to be recorded on the application fee and if the value is \$0 you are required to provide a reason e.g. related party trade

FUTURE REQUIREMENT

REASON FOR TRADE

The reason for **ALL** trades will need to be reported on the application form

(e.g. standard commercial, related party trade, allocation trade as part of share transfer)
