NOTICE TO CHARTER BOAT FISHERY LICENCE HOLDERS

Extension to the duration of the Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery

Dear Licence Holder,

I write to inform you that as delegate of the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development, I have extended the term of the *Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery* until 30 June 2022 (a period of 12 months). A copy of the notice implementing this decision is attached for your information.

The extension will support the timeframes required to allow a review of the *Management Plan for the South Australian Charter Boat Fishery* to be conducted, finalised and provided to the Minister for consideration and adoption prior to 30 June 2022.

The Department of Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) will work with the Surveyed Charter Boat Owners and Operators Association when undergoing the review and will seek support of the review and development of the new management plan.
