### Determination under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* which was received by the Department of Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) on 13 January 2026, seeking access to the following:

*“Information about the expenditure on the Reducing grazing pressure through kangaroo management grant, specifically:*

1. *In regard to the \$900,000 Field Harvest Support Grant:*

- How much of the total grant fund of \$900,000 has been spent?*
- How many Field Harvesters (Kangaroo shooters) have applied for the grant?*
- How many Field Harvesters were successful in accessing funding?*
- How many kangaroos were culled under this grant?*

2. *In regard to the \$350,000 Primary Producer Incentives:*

- How much of the total grant fund of \$350,000 has been spent?*
- How many Primary Producers have applied for the grant?*
- How many Primary Producers were successful in accessing funding?*
- How many kangaroos were culled under this grant?”*

Timeframe: 1/10/2025 to 12/01/2026

Please note that Question 1 of your request has been interpreted as follows:

- \$350,000 for the Field Harvester Support Grant; and
- \$550,000 for the Field Harvester Incentives Scheme.

Accordingly, the following determination has been finalised.

I have located four documents that are captured within the scope of your request.

**Determination**

I have determined that access to the following documents is **granted in full**:

The information removed from the above documents is outside of the scope of your request.

For clarity, I advise the following:

- Document 1 (Field Harvester Support Grant):
  - The expenditure refers to the applications (including those received prior to 1 October 2025) where payments were made between 1 October 2025 and 12 January 2026
  - Fifteen applicants applied for the Field Harvester Support Grant between 1 October 2025 and 12 January 2026.
  - Thirteen applications were successful in obtaining funding.
  - One applicant withdrew their application.
  - One application was in the assessment stage of the process.
  - The intention of this program is to increase capacity and skills and therefore no harvesting details are recorded/monitored.
  
- Document 2 (Primary Producer Incentives Grant):
  - Six applicants applied for the Primary Producer Incentives Grant.
  - All applicants were successful in obtaining funding.
  
- Document 3 (Field Harvester Incentives Grant):
  - The expenditure refers to payments made between 1 October 2025 and 30 November 2025, including the daily incentive for specific regions and the incentive per kangaroo. The information for December 2025 and 1 January to 12 January 2026 was not available at the date of receipt of your request.

OFFICIAL

- Thirty-seven applicants applied for the Field Harvester Incentives Grant.
- All applicants were successful in obtaining funding.
- Document 4 (Field Harvester Incentives Grant):
  - The expenditure does not include daily incentive funds for operating in less popular/less serviced area.
  - The number of kangaroos destroyed in December 2025 is provided, however, the number of kangaroos harvested was not available at the time of receipt of your request.

You are invited to lodge a new application with PIRSA if you wish to seek the information that was not available at the date of receipt of your request.
