- *Potatoes are a PCN Resistant variety*
- *Have been grown on sandy soils in a 1 in 5 year rotation*
- *Packaged in New Packaging or if in used packaging the packaging has been treated with 1% Sodium hypochlorite spray*
- *The packaging states "Not for Planting"*
- *The information provided in this request is true and accurate in every regard.*

The certification for interstate export of produce from South Australia is provided on the basis that the Minister for Agriculture Food and Fisheries and the Government of South Australia, to the extent permitted by law, accept no liability for any loss or damage caused or arising from either the detection of any soil or plant debris in any produce or the interstate export of produce from South Australia.

I also understand that the provision of the requested certification is dependant upon both the availability of PIRSA staff and their need to verify that the produce to be certified does meet all necessary entry requirements.
