Fisheries Management (River Fishery) Regulations 2017

For the purpose of regulation 10 relating to Periodic Returns – I make the following determinations –

Regulation 10(1) (provide information)

- (1) The holder of a licence in respect of the fishery must in respect of each calendar month during the currency of the licence complete a return form (return) contained within the South Australian Inland Waters Catch and Effort Return and deliver the return to the Department at the address provided in the South Australian Inland Waters Catch and Effort Return within 15 days of the end of the month to which it relates.
- (2) If the holder of a licence takes no aquatic resources under the licence during a particular calendar month, he or she is required to furnish a return in respect of that period indicating that no such aquatic resources were taken unless—
 - (a) the holder of the licence has already complied with this requirement in respect of the calendar month in which aquatic resources were last taken under the licence.
- (3) If the fishery has been closed for a whole calendar month, the holder of a licence is not required to provide a return for that month.

Regulation 10(2) (keeping of records)

- (1) The holder of a licence must—
 - (a) make a copy of each return that he or she completes under this determination before the return is sent or delivered to the Department; and
 - (b) retain the copy for a period of 12 months from the last day of the month to which the return relates.
