## Determination under the Freedom of Information Act 1991

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* which was received by Primary Industries and Regions SA (PIRSA) on 15 July 2020, seeking access to the following:

"Documents that quantify:

- 1. The number of expiation notices issued to people that have breached the Keep SA fruit fly free program from when it first started (legislative reference: Introduce Plant and Plant Material in Contravention of the Plant Health Act 2009, Section 7).
- 2. The date it first started.
- 3. The number of people that have asked for their expiation notice to be reviewed.
- 4. The number of people that have been successful in their review.
- 5. How many manned border stations exist.
- 6. How many each border station generate."
