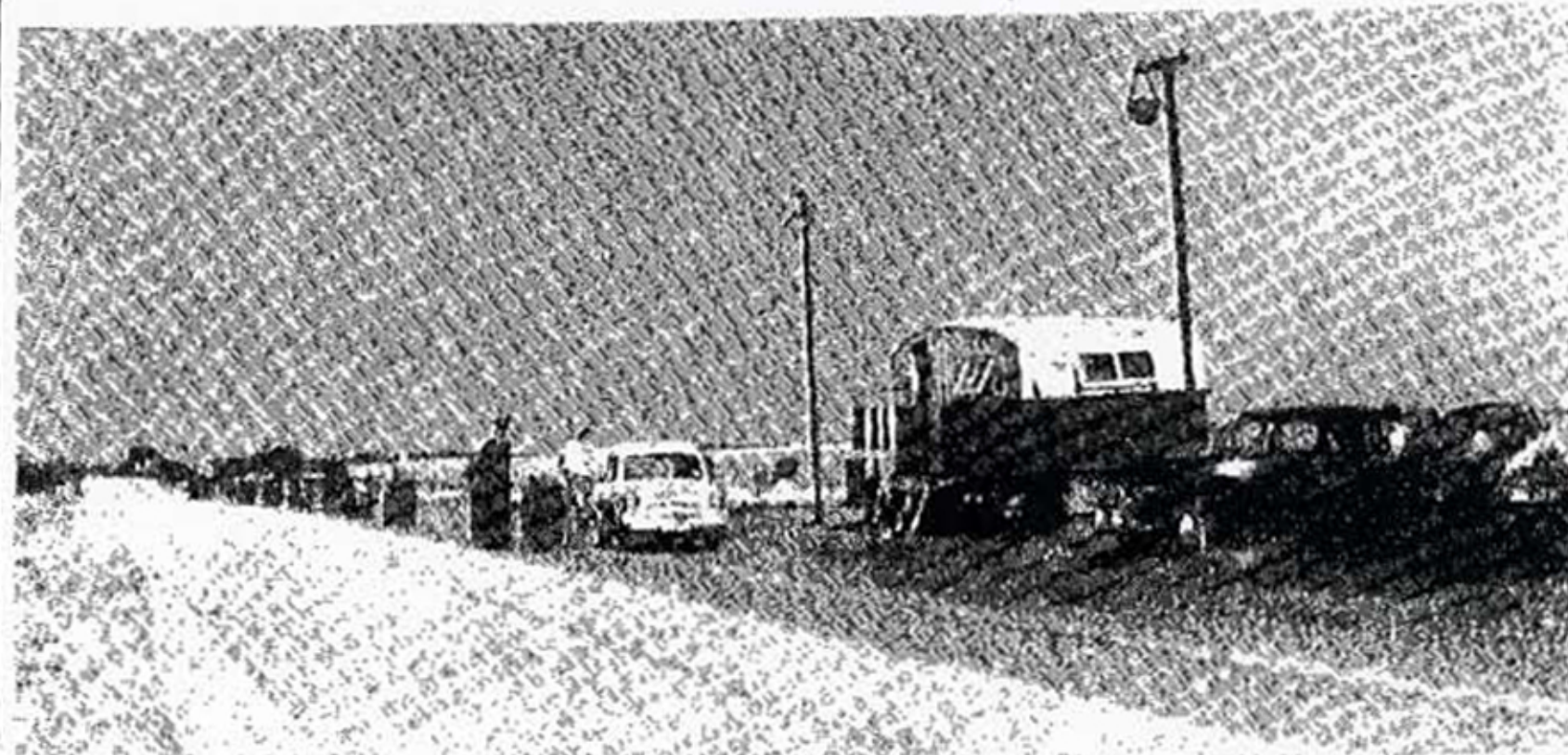
ROAD BLOCK NOW IN FULL SCALE OPERATION
