

Fisheries Management (Rock Lobster Fisheries) Regulations 2017

For the purpose of regulation 11 relating to the use of bait nets - make the following determination –

Regulation 11(1) (Notify use of bait nets)

- 1) Before a bait net registered for use under a licence in respect of the southern zone rock lobster fishery is set in state waters from a registered boat used under the licence, the licence holder or the registered master on such licence must notify the Department by PIRSA Ecatch via the PIRSA website www.pir.sa.gov.au/ecatch or telephoning 1800 322 824 (1800 eCatch) of the following information:
 - (a) his or her name; and
 - (b) the number of the licence under which the bait net is to be used; and
 - (c) the location at which the bait net is to be set; and
 - (d) the time at which the bait net is to be set; and
 - (e) the period of time for which the bait net is to be left in waters; and the species of fish that are to be targeted using the bait net.

- 2) Before a bait net registered for use under a licence in respect of the northern zone rock lobster fishery is set in state waters from a registered boat used under the licence the licence holder or the registered master on such licence must notify the Department by telephoning 1800 065 522 of the following information:
 - (a) his or her name;
 - (b) the number of the licence under which the bait net is to be used;
 - (c) the location at which the bait net is to be set;
 - (d) the time at which the bait net is to be set;
 - (e) the period of time for which the bait net is to be left in waters; and
 - (f) the species of fish that are to be targeted using the bait net.
